Leonz Zacharias Birchler and his family returned to Louisville before 1859. He bought property on the northeast corner of Jackson and Breckinridge Streets in 1860. In 1880, he built a house on Workhouse (Lexington) Road in Gillman's Point (St. Matthews), where he and his wife lived the rest of their lives.

In 1863 he enlisted in Company A of the 16th Regiment Ohio National Guards. In 1864 he was appointed Assistant Surgeon in the First Regiment of West Virginia Cavalry, and later was promoted to Surgeon of the Third West Virginia Cavalry. In the latter months of the war he served as acting Brigade Surgeon of the Third Brigade, Third Division of Cavalry, Custer's famous "Red Neck Tie" Brigade.
